

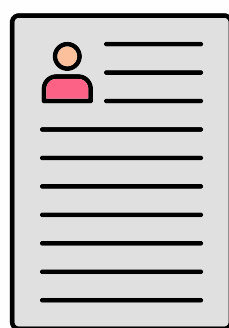
TIPS FOR SECURING YOUR IDEAL JOB

Understand what you're looking for in a job - industry, role, location, company, culture etc.



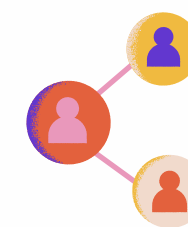
CRAFT A STRONG RESUME



Tailor your resume to highlight relevant skills, experiences, and achievements. Even if you don't have much work experience, include internships, volunteer work, projects, and relevant coursework.

NETWORK

Reach out to alumni, professors, family, friends, and professionals in your desired industry. Attend career fairs, networking events, and conferences. Connect with Recruiters in your desired industry.



UTILISE ONLINE JOB BOARDS

Websites like LinkedIn, Indeed, SEEK, and specific industry job boards are great places to find job listings. Set up job alerts for positions that match your interests and skills.



CUSTOMISE YOUR APPLICATIONS

Avoid sending out generic applications. Tailor your cover letter and resume for each job application, highlighting how your skills and experiences align with the job requirements.



PREPARE FOR YOUR INTERVIEW

Research the company, understand their mission, values, and recent news. Practice common interview questions and prepare examples to demonstrate your skills and experiences.



SHOW ENTHUSIASM & EAGERNESS TO LEARN

Employers often look for candidates who are motivated, adaptable, and willing to learn. Show your enthusiasm for the role and the company during interviews.



STAY PERSISTENT & POSITIVE



Job searching can be challenging and may take time. Stay persistent, keep applying, and don't get discouraged by rejections. Use any feedback you receive to improve your applications and interview skills.

CONTINUE LEARNING & BUILDING YOUR SKILLS

Use this time to further develop your skills through online courses, certifications, or freelance work. Continuous learning will not only enhance your resume but also make you a more competitive candidate.



REVIEW YOUR SOCIAL CHANNELS

Re-assess your current LinkedIn and job searching profiles, making sure they are accurate and up to date.
